### REMINDERS

- At least 1 player per team must be a SMOY parishioner. An adult SMOY parishioner needs to be the Team Contact.
- Tournament brackets are by grade and gender whenever possible
- Hoop height is 8' for K-2<sup>nd</sup> grade and 10' for 3<sup>rd</sup> -8<sup>th</sup> grade.
- Teams placed by grade as of the 19/20 school year. Teams of different grades will be placed in the higher grade level.
- Due to potential scheduling conflicts, players may register and play for only one team during the event.
- Games on the night of the event could begin as early as 5:00PM. Please be prepared. Final brackets/ start times will be emailed to the team contact early in the week of the event

- ✚ We will contact you the week of the tournament, with your starting time & court number. You are expected to contact your team members with information regarding the tournament. *We will not* call your team members.

### 3-on-3 Rules 2019

- Game times are posted. All teams are responsible to play on the right court, at the right time, against the right team, or they risk forfeit or a replay when possible.
- For Grades K thru 4<sup>th</sup>: Games are to 8 by one or 15 minutes; whichever comes first...win by 1.
- For Grades: 5<sup>th</sup> thru 8<sup>th</sup>: Games are to 10 by one or 15 minutes; whichever comes first. If the game is tied after 15 minutes without a team reaching 10 then overtime play begins (no new possession) until a team is ahead by 2 OR the first team to reach 12 period.
- Three point shots count as 2. Both feet behind the line.
- Must take ball back to the three point line ALWAYS after ANY change of possession.
- Alternate possession based on coin toss at the beginning of game.
- Players may pass, dribble, or shoot after checking the ball up top to begin play. The defense must take the ball back to the 3 point line after a turnover or rebound.
- For Grades 5<sup>th</sup> thru 8<sup>th</sup> - **No Stalling Rule** – Referees may call a violation if he deems that the offense is intentionally delaying play.
- Foul shots for GRADES 5<sup>TH</sup> THRU 8<sup>TH</sup> ONLY: **Beginning with 5<sup>th</sup> Team Foul (Shooting or Non-Shooting)**

  1. All foul shots are dead balls (clear the lane).
  2. Only 1 free throw will be awarded to any fouled player (make counts as 1) even if fouled shooting from behind the 2 point line.
  3. Shooting Fouls:
    - a. If the basket is made; count the basket and 1 free throw is awarded with next possession going to defense whether made or missed.
    - b. If the basket is missed and foul shot is made; defense gets ball
    - c. If the basket is missed and foul shot is missed; offense retains ball.
  4. Non-Shooting Fouls:
    - a. If the foul shot is made; defense gets ball.
    - b. If the foul shot is missed; offense keeps ball.

- **HARD FOULS**

We want to discourage hard fouls – this is a youth event. Any “Hard Foul” as determined by the referee (typically in the act of shooting) will result in the following:

  - a. 1<sup>st</sup> offense – Warning
  - b. 2<sup>nd</sup> offense – Player ejection for that game, team plays with 2 players.
- **FLAGRANT FOULS OR FIGHTING WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.**
  1. First Offense - Player ejection for that game, team plays with 2 players.
  2. Further Offenses - Player and Team ejection for the tournament.
- Please, no hanging on the rims. **The referees will have a brief MANDATORY meeting with all players from both teams before each game.**
- **PLEASE REMEMBER THIS IS A FUNDRAISER AND THAT WE ARE ONE PARISH COMMUNITY!**
