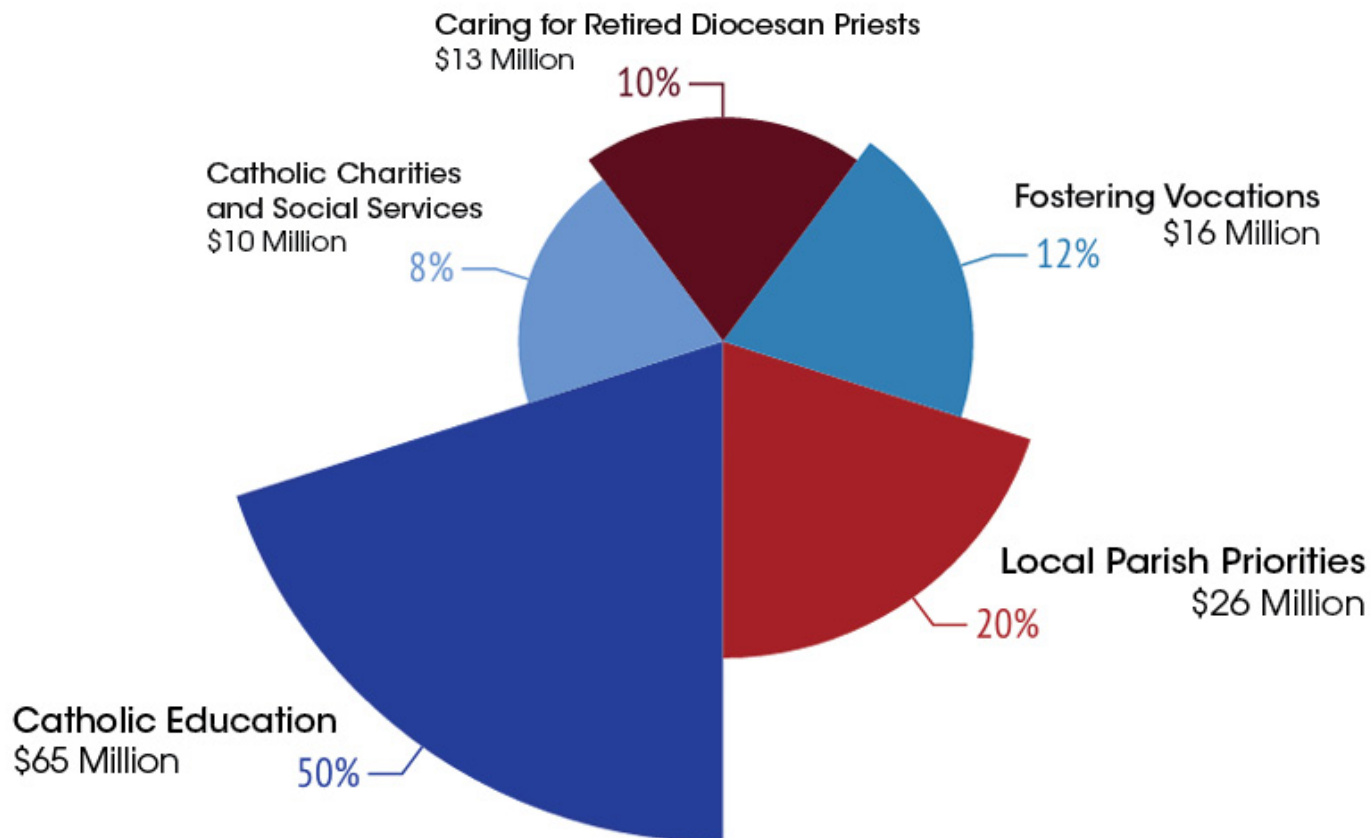

Street intersection does not transition to parking... transitions to a sidewalk. Restricts access to Parish Campus
