Get ready for nationally known keynote speakers, great music, breakout workshops and a chance to meet Jesus in a way you have never experienced before. Cost is \$300.

# Catholic Heart Work Camp Sunday, July 17 – Saturday, July 23

We will be traveling to Mary Help of Christians Academy in North Haledon, NJ. Our work there will be with many agencies, parishes and Catholic Schools in the Paterson, Newark and Elizabeth areas. We will also branch out into less urban areas of North Jersey. The worksites include homeless shelters, food pantries, low-income preschools, a friary, group homes for individuals with disabilities, Senior daycare, a nursing home and a convent, just to highlight a few. The week will include a number of retreat elements to our morning and evening programming including Mass, Adoration, and dynamic talks as well as time for fellowship. Cost for this trip is \$550 which also includes admission to our free day activities.

## Fish Fry Expectations

The Fish Fries are the fundraiser by which we help to pay for our summer ministry opportunities. More than that though, they are a chance to begin our call to service here within our own community. With that in mind we need each teen AND their family to step up to make the trips and ministry that our teens participate in during the summer possible. This is why there is **a requirement of 5 shifts from each family** per teen you may have attending trips. **At least 2 shifts per family must be completed by adults**. Of course, you are welcome and encouraged to work more than your minimum shifts.

#### Fundraising, Costs, and Payments

We always get questions about how the money is used for the trips. It's also important to know that the cost passed on to you for the trip does not reflect the total cost of sending your teen on that trip. There is a great portion including chaperone costs, gas, additional supplies, T-Shirts etc. that is not included in the final cost. This is why there is a Shift Requirement for Participants and Families at the Fish Fries.

We will also be participating in a Fundraiser through Tri State Fundraising. This fundraiser will involve selling coupon sheets. Families may choose to make a monetary donation to the general trip funds in lieu of participation. Our costs will be higher than usual this summer, which is why this additional fundraiser has been added.

We do this to make the trips as affordable for our families as possible while still being good stewards of the parish funds. With that in mind, our efforts in the Fish Fry and the additional fundraiser go to cover these additional costs and to keep your cost down.

#### Payment Schedule

- At Registration \$125 non-refundable deposit required to complete your registration.
- May 4<sup>th</sup> Final payment for balance of trip. \*

\* Money from the Fish Fries will be used first to cover parish incurred costs above the actual cost of your teen's trip. Remaining funds will be allocated evenly to all participants prior to the due date for the final payment.

#### **Cancellation and Refund Policies**

- The initial deposit of \$125 per person is non-refundable.
- Cancellations received **in writing** before April 1<sup>st</sup>: no cancellation fee.
- Cancellations received **in writing** April 1<sup>st</sup> May 4<sup>th</sup>: \$100 cancellation fee.
- If you cancel on or after May 4<sup>th</sup>, you are responsible for the full cost of your trip.
