
Sunday Reflection

Numbers 6:22-27; Galatians 4:4-7; Luke 2:16-21

Dear Friends: Once again, we experience January 1, and once again many people have been celebrating some more than they might admit!]. "Happy New Year!" is a wish that is shouted all over the planet as 2022 moves into 2023. For some, this is just a toast to go with a New Year's Eve party...for others it is a fervent desire for a better year than the past one was...for many it is simply a conventional way to greet one another as December 31st turns to January 1st. Whatever the reason, it is a good thing to wish one another a "Happy New Year!" This wish focuses on the future, and, for the Christian believer, hope in the future is not something of secondary importance, but it involves the core of our faith. A New Year is not fearsome, but filled with opportunities to serve, care, minister, grow and love. This year of 2023 will see people getting married, babies being baptized, young people being confirmed, and adults entering the Church. We will see students graduating and entering new schools, becoming part of the work force, and joining the military. Men will enter the seminary and be ordained, and people will enter religious life. We will make new friends, find new opportunities to forgive someone, be given the chance to grow stronger, and learn once again what it means to try and love God and one another. There is a great deal on the agenda for 2023! And with all that, the list is never complete. But it does remind us of how much is at stake, and how precious each year is...each day...each hour. 




