Sunday Reflection

Fr. Ed Smith

Isaiah 49:3, 5-6; 1 Corinthians 1:1-3; John 1:29-34

After the weeks of Advent and Christmas, with purple and white vestments, we are now back to "green": By this I mean that for the next seven Sundays we will be in "Ordinary Time" before our celebration of Ash Wednesday, when we begin Lent. And as we begin this 'in-between' time, we see John the Baptist [who showed up quite a bit during Advent] pointing to Jesus and proclaiming, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world." Why does John use the image of a lamb? Why not a soaring eagle or a courageous lion? What does a 'lamb' teach us about Jesus? It clearly implies gentleness, but more importantly it is a symbol of total self-giving. Consider that lambs were bred to give their wool, their skin, and even their fat, oil and their flesh for others. People have been kept warm, books have been bound, sores have been soothed and families have been fed with the different parts of lambs for centuries. One could say that the lamb sacrifices its entire self for the good of others. This is the reason that the lamb is one of the most beautiful and powerful symbols of Jesus. This is the reason we echo John the Baptist at every Eucharist: "Behold the Lamb of God!" We are reminded that Jesus, the Son of God, Lord of all, and the King of the universe is also the gentle Lamb who gives Himself completely to the will of His Father, and who sacrifices Himself on the cross out of perfect love for us. He is the Word made flesh in our world to show us that we are cherished, that we are important to our heavenly Father, and that we are never left alone in life. God is with us, God loves us, and, when we fail, the Lamb of God takes away our sins. Now think about it: if this is what we learn on just one Sunday during the routine of "ordinary time", just imagine what glorious revelations await us in the heavenly kingdom!

Catechetical Corner

Q&A

Reading the Bible

Question:

What is unique or different about the way Catholics read and are exposed to the Bible?

Answer:

Catholics are exposed to Scripture primarily through the Sunday readings from a book known as the Lectionary. The Lectionary is a book of selected passages from the Bible set in the context of a liturgical season, such as Advent, Lent, or ordinary time. There are four readings assigned to any Sunday: the first reading (usually from the Old Testament), the responsorial psalm, the second reading (usually from a New Testament letter), and the Gospel reading.

These readings together give them a new context. The selected readings relate to one another in a unique manner that is not present in the Bible text itself. In close proximity to each other, these readings now have the opportunity to converse with each other in a way that would have not been possible before. A homilist pays attention to all four readings, preparing a reflection that speaks of this conversation among the readings, enabling us to zero in on what this unique combination of God's word has to say to us this particular Sunday.

Next time you attend Sunday liturgy, try reading the Scripture ahead of time and see how this new relationship among the readings addresses and challenges you to be a better Christian here and now.

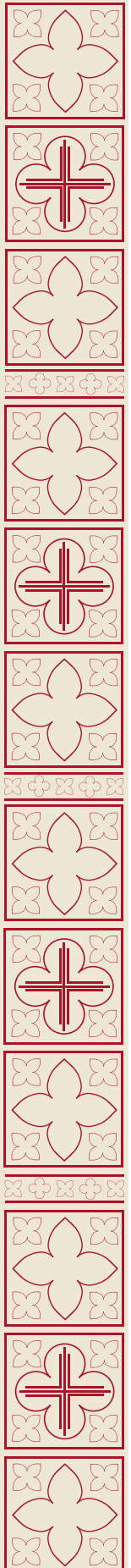
