Sunday Reflection

Fr. Ed Smith

Zephaniah 2:3, 3:12-13; 1 Corinthians 1:26-31; Matthew 5:1-12a

Our Gospel for this weekend is so versatile that it will show up at weddings, baptisms, confirmations and even funerals. The Beatitudes are extraordinary in many ways. What is it about this reading from the Gospel of St. Matthew that makes it so universal? First of all: the teaching is so basic that it is applicable to a number of life situations. Jesus describes for His listeners what their lives will be like if they follow Him. Secondly, it is a challenge to take the ideal that is given, and really live it out every day. Finally, it reminds us that we are called to be “blessed” [hence, the word “beatitudes for this passage”]. This blessedness does not just happen. We must take the Christ’s message in, live it out, and become the people He calls us to be. However, there is another important teaching in this Gospel, which connects beautifully with the other two readings today. We hear about the “humble and the lowly” [first reading], the “weak and the lowly” [second reading], and the “poor in spirit...and the persecuted” [Gospel reading]. These important words remind us that following Jesus is not always easy, that it involves humility and self-sacrifice, but that it will ultimately bring us to a glorious destiny with the Lord who loves us more than we could ask or imagine. We are very blessed indeed, to have our faith, to share in the Eucharist, to hear God’s Word proclaimed, and to be part of a community that is gathered together to praise the God who blesses us, over and over, with the gift of Himself in Jesus. This is extraordinary, and it makes every moment of our life a “blessing”!

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Discipleship Maker Index?

The Disciple Maker Index is a 75-question survey instrument providing a snapshot of the worshipping community here at St. Margaret of York. The survey was developed with bishops, pastors, pastoral ministers, and thought leaders. It has been administrated in many parishes and dioceses around the world. The survey is an opportunity for you to reflect on your individual spiritual growth in relation with the parish and your engagement with the parish.

Is the Discipleship Maker Index survey anonymous?

Yes – the Discipleship Maker Index does not collect any personal information.

How long does it take to complete the survey?

The Discipleship Maker Index is a 75-question multi-choice survey that typically 10–15 minutes to complete.

Why aren't there spaces to write comments on the Discipleship Maker Index?

The purpose of the Discipleship Maker Index is to take a snapshot of the faith community.

How will we use the data?

St. Margaret of York will use the data to discover where we succeed as a parish and where we need to improve. We will be able to see our strengths and our weaknesses. Where we are weak we want to become strong and this data will help us discover where we as a parish and where we need to improve.

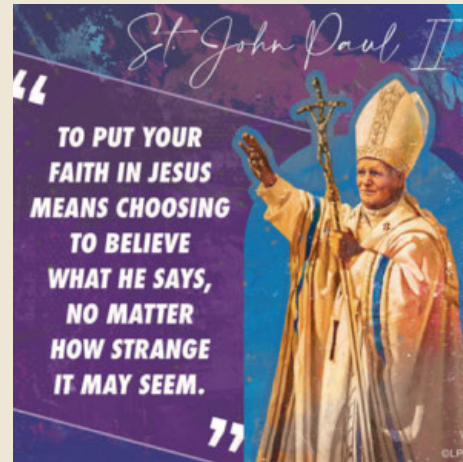
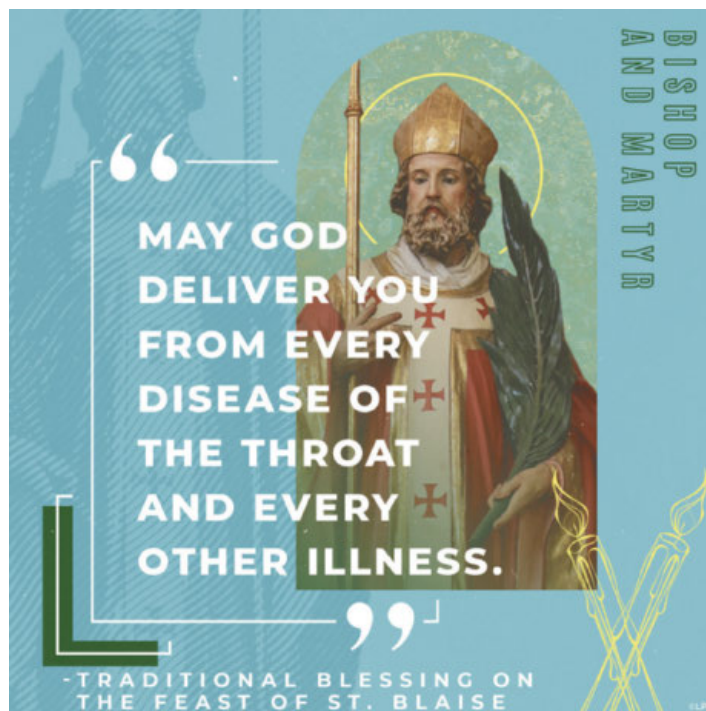

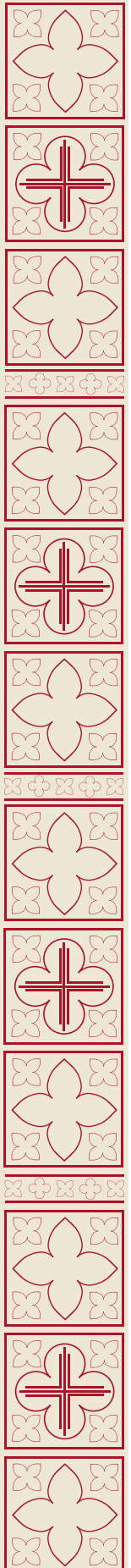
