The Messiah Before You

If you would have asked me on the morning of my confirmation what the chances were of the Holy Spirit getting into my heart, I would have told you they were about the same as getting water from a stone.

My faith was fragile at this time in my life, primarily because I viewed it as exactly that — my faith. Something within my possession and subject to my own power. And I hadn't done the things I thought I needed to do in order to be the kind of Christian who knows the truth and lives it. I was waiting to be made stronger. I was waiting to be made more faithful. I was waiting for a transformation.

Little did I know, I was like the woman at the well, standing around talking about the coming of the Messiah, unaware that he was standing right in front of me. She wasn't ready; she was still living in her sin. She was caught so unawares that she left her water jar at the well, rushing out to tell what she had seen.

When I was anointed with the oil it no longer mattered that I wasn't strong enough to break open the stone that I was convinced encased my heart — God's grace gushed forth through the cracks. While I certainly didn't become a perfect Christian — and never will, in this life - I did learn that when God tells you to strike, it's probably best not to second-guess Him.




Sunday Reflection

Exodus 17:3-7; Romans 5:1-2, 5-8; John 4:5-42

Imagine a world without water. Impossible. Because without this element we would not be here to imagine anything at all, considering that humans are 60% water! Today's readings are about water: from the grumbling of the Israelites in the desert that there was no water to quench their thirst, to the woman from Samaria who meets Jesus at a well. So, "Water" is our word for the day. And it is an important symbol for us to consider. Water means life; without it the land hardens into a desert wilderness. Water refreshes: it renews us when we are parched and dry; water is beautiful: look at a sparkling lake or a magnificent ocean. So, we reflect on life, refreshment and beauty. And when Jesus offers water to the Samaritan woman in the Gospel, He indeed offers the experience of true life, refreshment and beauty. Water, therefore, is universally used to express some very important realities. No wonder the Church uses it as the primary symbol for our very first sacrament: Baptism, which unites us to Jesus and makes us children of God. No wonder water is also used in the funeral ritual, sprinkled on the casket of someone who has died, reminding us of the beautiful eternal life that awaits that person. Between these two events in life [baptism and funeral] we have many encounters with the "Living Water" of Jesus, which cleanses, revives, strengthens, refreshes and awakens us to hope. It changes hearts, as it did with the Samaritan woman. All she wanted at the beginning was some water from the well, and, as usual, Jesus had much more to give. She was forever changed by her encounter with Him, and the Gospel assures us that "many came to believe in Jesus because of the woman who testified." May we be people of such faith, that, through our words and actions, others may come to know that life without Jesus, the Living Water, is truly unimaginable.






