


## Sunday Reflection

Fr. Ed Smith

Acts 6:1-7; 1 Peter 2:4-9; John 14:1-12

What a Gospel we have for you this weekend! Jesus talks about comfort, home, life and goodness. And I think most of us would agree that these are all part of what makes a house a home. And, as most families know, a home requires hard work...but at the same time it is filled with joy. Jesus understands this. He came to our earth to do hard work - the work of His Heavenly Father. And what is this work? Bringing comfort, life and goodness to God's people. And He tells us clearly in the Gospel that He is going ahead to prepare a home for us, so that we may always be with Him. But there is more to it than this: Jesus does not only prepare the way for us Jesus is the way for us. This means that it is through our relationship with Him that our lives have meaning and hope. Our future is in Him. When Jesus says that He is "the way the truth and the life," He gives us the promise that when we follow Him [the way] we have the assurance of our faith [the truth], and the promise of eternity with Him [the life]. No wonder this Gospel passage is perfect for this Easter season. It is a statement of confident hope: but not just hope in something, but in someone -Jesus! Just as so many of us are grateful to have a home and family in our lives, let us remember that it was God who gave us all this in the first place in order to comfort us, to create a dwelling place for us, to teach us about goodness, and to show us what it really means to love.



## Question & Answers

## **Obligation: Mass or Communion?**

#### **Ouestion:**

Are Catholics obligated to attend Mass each Sunday, or receive Communion each Sunday?

#### **Answer:**

The questions about Mass attendance and the reception of Holy Communion are clearly outlined in what are traditionally called the "Precepts" of the Church. These specific teachings are intended to stand alongside the Ten Commandments as fundamental practices for Catholics and are outlined in the Code of Canon Law. The obligations related to Mass attendance and receiving Communion are outlined in the first and third precepts, which we find quoted in the Catechism of the Catholic Church (no. 2042):

The first precept ("You shall attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation and rest from servile labor") requires the faithful to sanctify the day commemorating the Resurrection of the Lord as well as the principal liturgical feasts honoring the mysteries of the Lord, the Blessed Virgin Mary, and the saints; in the first place, by participating in the Eucharistic celebration, in which the Christian community is gathered, and by resting from those works and activities which could impede such a sanctification of these days.

The third precept ("You shall receive the sacrament of the Eucharist at least during the Easter season") guarantees as a minimum the reception of the Lord's Body and Blood in connection with the Paschal feasts, the origin and center of the Christian liturgy.

Rather than seeing these as obligations that are simply to be fulfilled out of a sense of duty, Pope Saint John Paul II reminds us of the grace that is made available to us when we gather for Sunday celebrations of the Eucharist: "Sunday is the day which is at the very heart of the Christian life... Time given to Christ is never time lost, but is rather time gained, so that our relationships and indeed our whole life may become more profoundly human" (Dies Domini, no. 7).

## Everyday Stewardship

What do you think is the value of your stewardship? Do you believe that through your actions both great and small that God can touch people, heal them, and change their lives? Too often we can mistakenly assume that what we do, say, or offer can have little effect in the grand scheme of life. We are simply poor sinners in need of salvation so what could we do anyway?

Jesus speaks very powerfully to what can be done by those who believe in him and follow him. He says in John's Gospel, "Amen, amen, I say to you, whoever believes in me will do the works that I do, and will do greater ones than these, because I am going to the Father." Greater ones than these? Think about all the miracles of Jesus recorded in sacred Scripture. You and I can do works greater than those?

St. Teresa of Avila said, "Christ has no body now on earth but yours." We are Christ to a world that needs him. It is the Christ in you that responds to the Christ in me. If it were only you alone going about doing good works and deeds, then your stewardship would amount to little. But if you bear the name Christian, and you approach your discipleship seriously, you can truly do greater things. If you understand your stewardship as a way that Jesus works in our world, then this way of life, cultivating and sharing your gifts at every turn, becomes more valuable than all the gold in the world.






