
Sunday Reflection

Fr. Ed Smith

Zechariah 9:9-10; Romans 8:9, 11-13; Matthew 11:25-30

The 4th of July is a significant day for me and my relationship with our parish: July 4, 2022, was the date of my first Mass as the new parochial vicar [assistant] at St. Margaret of York. And who would have thought then that 12 months later I would be officially assigned as your pastor! It's hard to believe that I have been here a year already. All of you have made the time go so fast! We have been making a holy journey together, and I am very grateful that you are in my life. The 4th of July also brings to mind for me a long-ago visit to the Statue of Liberty, and especially the impact of the words inscribed on it: "Give me your tired, your poor..." In the Gospel reading provided for us for this weekend. Jesus says something similar, but much more powerful: "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest." Jesus, like the statue, points out a harbor of safety and the promise of a better life. But Jesus goes far beyond what even our great country can pledge. Because Jesus gives us an invitation to share in His life. Moreover, in our Gospel passage for this Sunday, His offer follows an astonishing prayer of ecstasy and praise, in which the intimate relationship of the Father and the Son is revealed, as well as how important we [the 'little ones'] are to Jesus. So, when He says: "Come to me," He is drawing us into His life with the Father and the Holy Spirit...a life in the Trinity...a life of perfect love. And Jesus wants us to understand how important our lives are to Him: He instructs us and wants us to know that we are unconditionally loved by God; He comforts us in our times of pain, grief and distress; and He calls us to salvation: a life with Him in heaven forever. This is why we can and must "Come to Him" time and time again: He is everything we need. He is the answer to all our hopes. He is Jesus. And He gives us a reason for celebrating our freedom as God's beloved children, and to celebrate it every day...not only on the 4th of July, or even a one-year anniversary of being at this wonderful parish!





Safe Parish: Revised Decree on Child Protection

The Archdiocese of Cincinnati, in keeping with its policies, has completed the five-year revision of the Decree on Child Protection. Each user with a SafeParish account will need to download, acknowledge to have read, and agree to abide by the requirements of the revised Decree. If this is not completed within 30 days of the promulgation of the Decree by the Archbishop, the user's SafeParish account will show as pending until the user completes the acknowledgement. Users with pending SafeParish accounts are not permitted to work or volunteer with youth until they have met all the child protection requirements and their SafeParish account is approved. Question & Answers

Coming Back to Church

Ouestion:

I have been away from the Church for a few years and really want to get active again, not so much for me, but for my children. Is this a bad reason to come back to Church?

But God's grace comes to us in ways we understand and recognize and need. Your children leading you back to the Church is not as important as the fact that you are back.

This is an opportunity for you to renew, strengthen, and deepen your faith. Regardless of how we get to Church, or what draws us closer to God, the fact is we are there. Do what you need to do to get right with God and the Church. Go to confession, begin good family religious practices, and be involved in the ministries your parish offers. Be more than a lukewarm parishioner. Be the kind of Catholic you want your children to be.
