## Sunday Reflection

Fr. Ed Smith

#### Isaiah 22:19-23; Romans 11:33-36; Matthew 16:13-20

As we begin a new school year and think about how each year of our education builds on the previous one as we grow in knowledge and understanding, it seems that someone is always in the midst of building something. Jesus is also building. In today's Gospel, He tells Peter: "Upon this rock I will build my church." Question: What does this have to do with us? Answer: We are the descendants of Peter. We are the Church. We continue to be part of the first building project begun by Jesus with the first apostle. This architectural imagery reminds us that our lives of faith are built gradually and carefully, with prayer, trust, openness, reflection, generosity and love. That's a tall order, and it is only possible because Jesus is with us from the beginning and remains with us until the end. Notice in the Gospel that it is Jesus who begins the dialogue with Peter ["Who do you say that I am?"]. Peter then responds to this important question ["You are Christ, the Son of the Living God!"]. Then, Jesus gives Simon his new name of Peter [which means "Rock"] and his new mission ["Upon this Rock I will build my church"]. The same is true for us. Jesus begins the conversation and asks us who He is for us. But then we must keep listening to hear what He wants to do with us. And, if you think about it, in one way or another, we are all called to the same basic vocation: to help build up the Church. So, whether we are beginning a new school year, raising a family, ministering to the poor, going to work every day, or many other possibilities, we are part of God's great commission for Peter and all who call themselves Christians. We are doing our small part to build up the Kingdom of God!

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

On November 7, 2023, Ohioans will have the opportunity to demonstrate how our state views the sacredness of life and the dignity of women. On the November ballot will be a proposed amendment (deceptively named "The Right to Reproductive Freedom with Protections for Health and Safety") to the Ohio Constitution that would enshrine the "right" to take the lives of innocent children in the womb while harming women and families in the process.

An expectant mother of any age can face many challenges, including lack of support from the father, financial strains, concerns about her own health and that of her child, and pressures from family and friends. Every woman, regardless of circumstances, should be able to depend upon a community of support. That is why Catholic social service agencies, in collaboration with many other faith-based and secular organizations, assist pregnant women in need with material resources and personal accompaniment, both during pregnancy and after their child is born.

By contrast, the proposed amendment does none of that. If enacted, it would amend the Constitution of Ohio to effectively:

- Put women at risk. This amendment would enable elimination of some of the most basic, fundamental safety regulations on abortion clinics, including the current requirement for an abortion to be performed by a licensed physician.
- Threaten parental rights. The vague language in the amendment opens the door to anyone
  under 18 having an abortion, or even beginning cross-sex hormone treatment, without parental
  consent or notification.
- Allow abortion through 9 months of pregnancy. The amendment provides caveats such that
  a healthy, fully-formed infant in the womb who otherwise could be delivered with no issues
  would still be a candidate for a surgical dismemberment abortion.

We must reject this extraordinary and dangerous attempt to radically reshape Ohio through a constitutional amendment that does nothing to aid women or promote life.

The amendment's supporters will claim that its passage is necessary to preserve medical treatment for women who experience miscarriages or ectopic pregnancies. This is not true. No Ohio laws – or the laws of any U.S. state, for that matter – prevent such treatment. Hospitals, including Catholic hospitals, and physicians have always provided comprehensive miscarriage care, and will continue to do so regardless of the outcome of this vote.

Some may insist that the Catholic Church should not be involved in politics. However, the defense of life and care for women compels our participation in this critical moral issue. As Catholics, we are morally obliged to uphold the dignity of life of all vulnerable humans – immigrants, the poor, preborn children. We cannot remain silent on a direct ballot question like the one in November. The Church must not remain on the sidelines when confronted with such a clear threat to human life and dignity and the primacy of the family.

Ohio does not need a constitutional amendment that only perpetuates violence and a culture of death. I urge Catholics and all people of goodwill to pray earnestly for the defeat of this extreme amendment; to educate yourselves and your family and friends about the dangers of the proposed amendment; and to vote NO on November 7. Beyond that, we must continue our commitment to caring for women, children and families.

May the Blessed Virgin Mary, mother of our Lord and Savior, and St. Joseph, protector of the family, intercede for Ohio and its families in the weeks ahead.

Non-perishables: Donations can be left in the box opposite the Parish Office and will be distributed among the SMOY SVdP, Kings, and Loveland LIFE pantries.



## **Practicing Catholic**

#### Who Do You Say That I Am?

I once knew a very devout woman whose adult godchild had fallen away from the practice of the faith. This godchild still believed in God, and even felt a sense of belonging in the Church. He was a good and kind person. But poor catechesis and a society that confuses pleasure with joy had left him lax in practice, without an appreciation of the sacraments. He was making choices that threatened his soul.

His godmother wanted more for him. She planned to speak with him about his life, hoping to encourage him to return to the practice of the faith. She knew that, when she brought this up, he would reply that it wasn't important to attend Mass or to receive the Eucharist, that was all just "extra."

She told me that she was going to begin their conversation by asking him the question Jesus poses to Peter in Matthew 16:15 - the critical question in all our lives, the question whose answer will define what we become in this world and the next.

Her godson knew the answer. She was confident, unshakably, that he did. He may have forgotten it or ignored it. He may have tried to convince himself he wasn't entirely sure. He may have refused to give an answer. But he knew it. He knew the answer.


There is a reason that, after Peter's response, Jesus gives him the keys to the kingdom of heaven.




