



Sunday Reflection

Fr. Ed Smith

Isaiah 5:1-7; Philippians 4:6-9; Matthew 21:33-43

Most of us tend to appreciate it when people speak clearly. Jesus does this very well. He does not mince words. And one of the many marvelous things about the Gospels is how clearly Jesus can teach us exactly what we need to learn. Today's parable is a case in point. Jesus tells us that we are loved deeply by God, who sends us messenger after messenger to help us along in the journey of life and faith. And how have these messengers been treated? The parable says: "one they beat, another they killed, and a third they stoned." Finally, God sends His Son, and it seems that this would be the end of the issue. But, as the parable tells us, even the Son was killed by the vineyard workers. What in the world is going on here? First, it is an indictment about Israel, and their refusal to accept the prophets of the Old Testament, and, after them, Jesus and His message of the Kingdom. However, it goes beyond this historical moment, and challenges us today to be alert to the fact that God continues to send messengers to us to bring His invitation to holiness and love. He trusts us to care for the 'vineyard' of faith and life...He wants us to listen to Him. He demands that we follow His will. He wants only the best for us. When we ignore His message, we can easily find ourselves absorbed in a selfishness that 'kills' goodness and true faith. This is not the life we were born to live. Jesus uses today's parable to wake people up, let them know that there is more to their life than they ever imagined, and invite them [and us] to labor in His vineyard with joy. This is why the Gospel, even with its harsh moments, is called "Good News!"






