


Sunday Reflection

Fr. Ed Smith

Isaiah 45:1, 4-6; 1 Thessalonians 1:1-5b; Matthew 22:15-21

People sometimes ask: "What was the personality of Jesus like?" Scholars of the Bible have pondered this for generations. Some say He would have been intense and serious, others that He was warm-hearted and gentle, still others that He was engaging and a great story-teller. All of these are true, of course, but today's Gospel gives us another aspect of Jesus: He was really clever. The Pharisees and their henchmen try to trip Jesus up with a foolish question about paying the census tax to Caesar, the emperor of Roman army that was occupying Jewish territory. How does Jesus answer them? First, He has the Pharisees show Him one of the coins they use in everyday life. It has the face of Caesar on it. Evidently, they are already using these Roman coins in their marketing time after time...so why in the world would they not use the same type of coin for the tax? It seems that Jesus is having a bit of fun with them. He takes their pettiness and shows how ridiculous it is. But even in this little, clever exchange, Jesus teaches a profound truth. He says: "Repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God." If we think about it, we realize that everything, in the end, belongs to God anyway! So, as we live on this earth, we must obey the laws and pay our taxes...this is what it means to be a mature person in the world. But we also need to remember that our ultimate allegiance is to God, who gives us every good gift, brings us together to share His wonders, and teaches us to love through the perfect example of Jesus, who was not certainly clever but, more importantly, lived out the message He taught, and calls us to embrace the message of our Responsorial Psalm and "Give the Lord glory and honor!"






