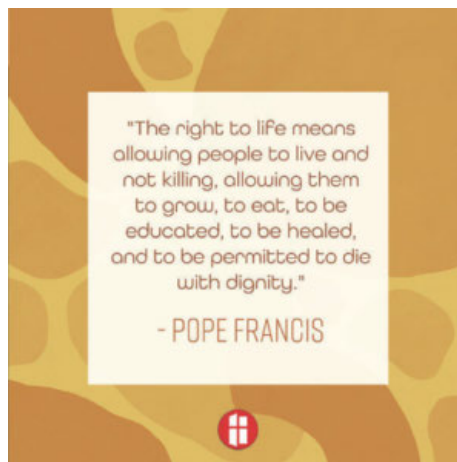

Sunday Reflection

Fr. Ed Smith

Isaiah 45:1, 4-6; 1 Thessalonians 1:1-5b; Matthew 22:15-21

I remember talking with some of the students at our school during my first months here. They asked a lot of things, but one question I remember was "What is the most important thing you do?" This is difficult to answer, since, for me and for all of us, there are probably many answers to this kind of inquiry. Jesus is asked in today's Gospel, "Which commandment in the law is the greatest?" This is, however, not asked out of genuine interest, but to test Jesus, or even trap Him. Jesus answers these faithless people by quoting one of the most beloved verses in the Old Testament, which would have been well-known to His adversaries: "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul and with all your mind." But then, Jesus completes the commandment by telling them [and us] to "love your neighbor as yourself." What is astonishing is that Jesus, in His wisdom, shows us that these two commandments are, in fact, not two, but essentially one commandment. Loving God presupposes loving our neighbor; and loving our neighbor is impossible without loving God and seeing Him in others. So, once again, Jesus gives the Pharisees much more than they bargained for - something that could change their lives: a vision of love for God and neighbor that springs from the heart of who God is and how He works in the hearts of His people. This is what we are to have in our lives...and it is, without doubt, the "most important" thing we will ever do!

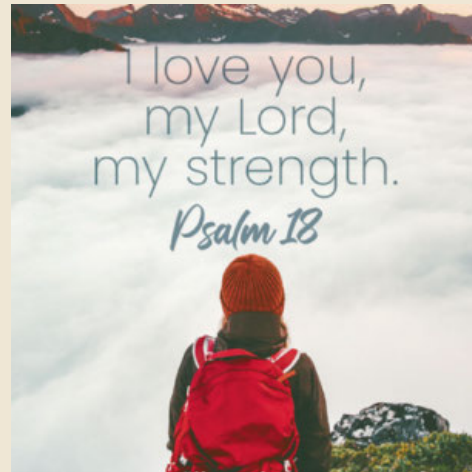
Caregiver Mass at Cathedral Basilica of St. Peter in Chains

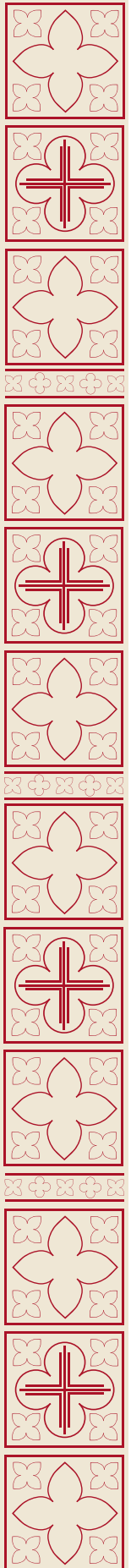
