

Sunday Reflection

Fr. Ed Smith

Wisdom 6:12-16; 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18; Matthew 25:1-13

Our first reading for this weekend is from the Book of Wisdom. Father Tim Schehr, a long-time professor of Scripture at our seminary, wrote that this book teaches us three very important things: 1. *Believe that you are special to God*; 2. *Pray for the gift of wisdom*; 3. *Keep in mind that the benefits go beyond this world*. It is wisdom that teaches us who we are and how we are to live. It is wisdom that gives us a healthy perspective to know when to let things go and not allow them to bother us. It is wisdom that teaches us discipline and foresight. It is wisdom that helps us deepen as individuals and surrender ourselves to the source of all wisdom: God Himself. Now, let's move to the Gospel for this weekend. The parable of the wise and foolish virgins [bridesmaids] makes it clear that wisdom is not just something abstract in our lives but involves practical decisions and thinking ahead. Jesus tells us that five of the virgins are wise and five are foolish. The wise ones were ready for the bridegroom's return, and the foolish ones were not, and so all they can do at his coming is to make demands of the others. "Give us some of your oil," they say, so their torches will not go out. But life doesn't work that way. We all have to get our own "oil". This means that each of us has to grow in wisdom and respond to God's call to know, love and serve Him. It is foolish to presume that we can steal or cheat or buy our way to heaven [meeting the Bridegroom] by demanding the wisdom, holiness and faith that belongs to others. It must be our own. It must be worked for and cultivated. So, we end with some questions: What is worth seeking? Waiting for? Loving? The answer, found through holy wisdom, is GOD. It is this insight that enables us to pray the words of our Responsorial Psalm and really mean them: "My soul is thirsting for you, O Lord my God!"




