Sunday Reflection

Fr. Ed Smith

Ezekiel 34:11-12, 15-17; 1 Corinthians 15:20-26, 28; Matthew 25:31-46

"Lord, when did we see you hungry...thirsty...a stranger... naked...ill...in prison?" If you think about it, these questions from the 'sheep on the right hand of Jesus' in the Gospel should be something all of us ask at one time or another. Today we celebrate the solemnity of Christ the King. And several things are happening today. It is the final Sunday of the Church's liturgical year; it; it is the first weekend of the traditional holiday season with Thanksgiving Day last Thursday; it is a time when many families are gathered to celebrate; and it is the last weekend before the season of Advent. There is, as I said, a lot going on. But no matter how much is happening in our lives or even in the life of the Church, our readings remind us that we are rooted in the love of a tender Shepherd, who teaches us what is essential in life: That we see Him in our lives, recognize His love, and put love into action. This is how our faith is lived out, as we see Jesus in the faces of the suffering, the sad, the poor and the hungry. Among the several amazing statements from the Scriptures today, perhaps the one that strikes home is when Jesus says: "Whatever you did for one of the least brothers of mine, you did for me." In doing what we can for "the least" we grow in becoming the people God created us to be: We become His images of love in the world. So, let us celebrate this feast with great devotion to Jesus, with gratitude for our faith, and with a strong resolve to respond to the needs of those who desperately need our help. In doing so, we can ask that guestion: "Lord, when did we see you?" with confidence, knowing that we have looked for Him in our brothers and sisters, in the world He has given us, in the families that helped form who we are, and in the faith which gives direction to our lives. Let us all work for lives of goodness and kindness, in imitation of Jesus Christ, our Shepherd, Brother, Savior and King!



What Remains

When my grandfather died, my parents, siblings, and I were left with the question: what's to become of the house?

Anyone who has inherited property knows that it's not simply a matter of assuming ownership of a plot of land upon which sits four walls and a roof. Those four walls and a roof usually contain memories and objects — an enormous volume of both, in the case of my grandfather. When they're left to you, you have to sift through them, the memories and the objects, and with each one you have to think: Is it worth it? Do I keep it? Will I need it?

And slowly, painfully, you disassemble the physical existence of the person who lived here. You accept, with a pang, that most of it must be given away or discarded. You cry when you bag up the clothes to take to Goodwill. You can't even bear to look when they break the piano into a hundred pieces and throw it in a dumpster, realizing that no one wants or has a use for something that was once so precious.

But when you come upon a rosary that was used so many times it has begun to fall apart, you don't even think twice before keeping it, and not because you need the rosary. You need what it means. You need what it reminds you of.

When all is said and done, each of us will be called before our master to settle accounts, just as my grandfather was.

"Where are the gifts I gave you? What remains of the fortune to which I entrusted you?" he will ask us. "What have you done with the peace? What have you done with the love? What have you done with the mercy?"

Everyday Stewardship

I remember watching a television show about a high school that dug up a time capsule that students had buried twenty-five years earlier. They had buried it with the purpose of showing others many years later the trends of the day and how student life was at that time. It was a fun exercise and everyone—the current students as well as those now grown—laughed at the clothing styles, corny photos, and lack of technology from years ago.

I wonder how the former students felt about how they had grown in those twenty-five years. How many of them realized their high school dreams? Did they find their purpose in this world and feel fulfilled in life? Did they use the talents and gifts God gave them to really make a difference in the world?

We have all been given talents and gifts by God to be cultivated and offered back to him and those around us for his glory. As time has passed, hopefully we have taken seriously our stewardship of these gifts. But sometimes out of fear, misunderstanding, or even apathy, we have taken one or more of our gifts and buried them, hiding them away from others and stifling all growth. This is no way to honor God and certainly not a path to fulfillment in life. If we have anything buried in our backyard we might do well to dig it back up, clean it up, and begin building upon it. Like a time capsule, those things will not be buried forever. One day the giver of that gift will ask what you have done with it. When that day comes, I pray you don't need to find a shovel.
