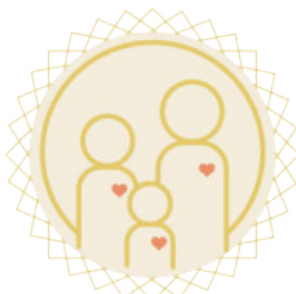

Sunday Reflection

Fr. Ed Smith

Sirach 3:2-6, 12-14; Colossians 3:12-21; Luke 2:22-40

The word "family" means many things in our world today. People talk about the 'nuclear' families, 'ancestral' families, 'extended' families, and even 'dysfunctional' families! Perhaps we think that it is only recently that ideas about family have been explored. But the concept of what makes up a family has been developing for centuries. During the time of Jesus, "family" included all the relations, no matter how distant, as well as the close friends of a person. No matter how it is perceived or spoken about, the truth is that not only is the family important, but, for most of us, it is pivotal in our own growth as human persons. Jesus Himself experienced the beauty and power of a family in which to grow up. The final words of today's Gospel tell us: *"The child grew and became strong, filled with wisdom, and the favor of God was upon him."* Imagine this being said of any one of us!

What a marvelous life we would be leading. What a graced existence we would have. What a holy family we would be! Today's feast of the Holy Family reminds us that being a family in this, or any other age, takes hard work and sacrifice. It takes commitment and love. It takes faith. This is what it means to be a true, Christian family. To be sure, it is not easy, and never has been. However, it is our call as God's children to be united in care and compassion for one another as a family. For this to happen, we must follow the example of the young Jesus, and grow strong, be filled with wisdom, and be open to the grace of God which can transform us into images of His love. God certainly knew what He was doing when He gave us families!

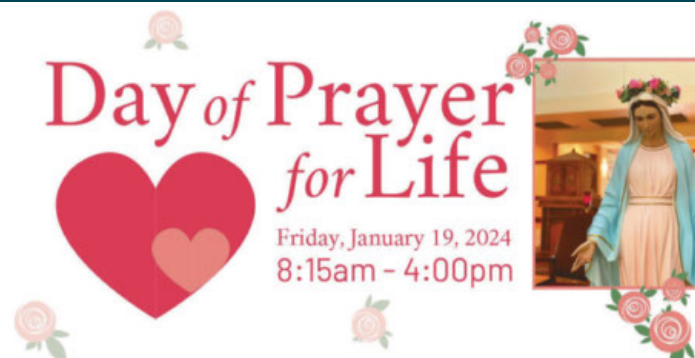

Mental health first aid


