Sunday Reflection

Fr. Ed Smith

Deuteronomy 18:15-20; 2 Corinthians 7:32-35; Mark 1:21-28

Whenever I encounter one of my students whom I taught back in the mid 1980's, often my first inclination is to ask, "Who are you?!" since I have not seen them for over thirty years. It seems a rather rude question, but a necessary one if the conversation is ever to move beyond mere pleasantries.

Well, for the next several weeks in our Gospels, this question keeps coming up about Jesus: "Who are you?" But unlike meeting someone from the past, often this question is the result of people meeting Jesus for the very first time. Imagine what an extraordinary experience it must have been to encounter Jesus face to face. One could hardly remain uninterested or passive in front of Him.

Being in the presence of Jesus demands a response. And what a response He gets in today's Gospel! Even an unclean spirit can say something about who He is. In our Gospel passage we hear the phrase [ironically from the unholy one] saying to Jesus: "I know who you are, the Holy One of God!" The people around Jesus were "astonished" and "amazed" and they began talking about Him all throughout the region of Galilee.

Why did all of this happen so dramatically? St. Mark tells us that this was in response to hearing Jesus teach with great authority. What He says matters. What He teaches has power. What He commands happens. If this is true, then a good question for each of us to ask is, "Who is Jesus?" Or perhaps, more personally, "Who is Jesus *for me*?" This is one of the core questions of life. It is certainly one of the key issues of Mark's Gospel. And in this Gospel we are taught that it is critical to ask the question, answer it honestly, listen to Jesus, and walk by faith in Him! So, we should never be afraid to ask Jesus: "Who are you?"



