Sunday Reflection

Fr. Ed Smith

Leviticus 13:1-2, 44-46; 1 Corinthians 10:31-11:1; Mark 1:40-45

Three simple words: "Be made clean." And everything changes for the leper who asked to be healed. The leprosy leaves him immediately. Jesus then demands the seemingly impossible. He tells him, "See that you tell no one anything". How could the man not tell anyone? He probably wants to tell everyone! Is he supposed to hide the fact that he was healed? Why would he want to? Why should he? A few things are important to consider here. Among them is the instant response of Jesus to the request of the leper. In fact, in a different translation of this verse of the Gospel, the sense of urgency for both the leper and Jesus is made clearer. The leper says, "If you want to, you can cure me." Jesus responds, "Of course I want to! Be cured!" The one who suffers is desperate for healing, and the One who wants to heal desires this with all His heart. Jesus wants the best for us, and the best on our part is that we give ourselves over to Him in faith and trust. Jesus responds with healing, forgiveness and grace. But then there is that curious line in which Jesus says that the leper who has been cured is not to tell anyone about the healing. And, logically, we ask, "Why not? The answer: because Jesus did not want to be known as a mere "worker of wonders" or a "magical healer". He was much more than this, and faith in Him demands much more. Also, He desired that people come to Him not because of the great deeds He performed, but because of His message of the Kingdom of God. In calling all people, sick or well, rich or poor, powerful or weak, to fullness of life, Jesus proclaimed the reality of His Kingdom, and that it was open to all. So, Jesus is reaching out to each of us, inviting us in, and letting us know that: of course, He wants to bring us healing, compassion and peace!

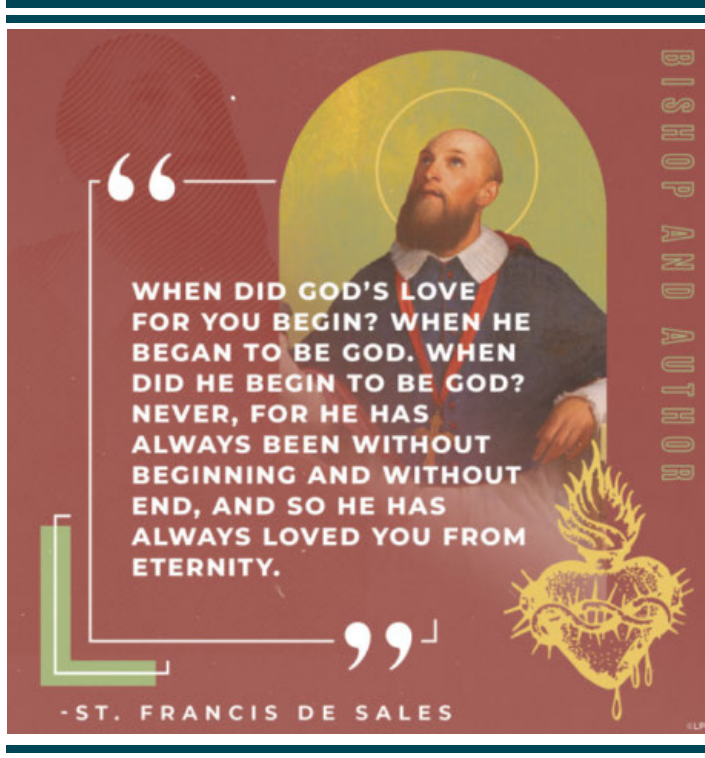
