
# Sunday Reflection

Fr. Ed Smith

Jeremiah 31:31-34; Hebrews 5:7-9; John 12:20-33

Happy St. Patrick Day! His memorial reminds us of how important it is to bring the message of Jesus to everyone we meet. We do this by being honest about the struggles of life and the gift that our faith is in these situations. We know that Jesus is compassionate, healing, embracing, loving and joyful. However, in today's Gospel reading, it seems that all that has changed. Jesus Himself seems to be in a struggle and even says that He is "troubled". Why this change? He knows that Good Friday is coming. He understands the terrible suffering that awaits Him. But, at the same time, He also proclaims that "the hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified." Jesus sees the reason for His suffering and knows that He is never abandoned by His Father. In today's intense and beautiful passage from St. John's Gospel we are given an intimate look into the soul of Jesus, and the assurance that, in His acceptance and embrace of suffering, He truly understands our own suffering. He knows that good can come from it, and that we can even find "glory" in it. In these last weeks of Lent, the Church's readings become more and more focused on the events of Holy Week: the entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, the celebration of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, the Passion and Death of Jesus on Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday of the Resurrection. Knowing that Lent ultimately leads us to Easter enables us to look at Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane and not despair. We can share His hope, His confidence, and His surrender to the Father's will. This is part of the "new covenant" of which the prophet Jeremiah speaks. We are God's children. Or, as our Heavenly Father says through the prophet: "I will be their God, and they shall be my people." We are God's people, though joy and hope, as well as through pain and suffering. God is always with us!!

# Everyday Stewardship

### When Our Own Hour Comes

We parents know that it's tricky, tackling the topic of fear with our kids. We want them to know that it's okay to be scared, that it's something we all feel from time to time. We want them to understand that bravery isn't the absence of fear, but the choices we make in persevering despite that feeling.

Most of all, we want to model the right kind of behavior for our kids. Whatever our scary situation is — illness, a job loss, life changes — we want them to see us make a choice to face that fear head-on.

Jesus seems to be the parent who is gently broaching the topic of fear with his children. A great sense of foreboding hangs over these readings. Jesus knew what was coming. He knew it was going to be hard, both for him and for his followers, who did not have his courage. Even he admits to being "troubled" and he speaks of "the time of judgment." There is the dramatic raising of Lazarus, the talk of how a grain of wheat must die in order to bear fruit, the depiction of Christ as an obedient student of his own suffering.

"Yet what should I say?" he asks them. "Father, save me from this hour?' But it was for this purpose that I came to this hour."

This week, Christ gives us a very parental gift: He shows us his fear, and he shows us how to conquer it. He challenges us to embrace the purpose for which we came to this hour whatever that hour may hold.



# **Lost in the Crowd**

I write my phone number on my kids' arms when we go into large crowds at summer festivals, in case we get separated. If you think this makes me sound like a neurotic person with an overactive imagination who watches too many true crime documentaries, you would be correct. I am all of those things.

However, I am also practical, and I've endured moments of panic after looking up and briefly not being able to locate a child who has wandered off or lagged behind. The phone number, scrawled across their sunscreen-streaked skin, is a safeguard, however insignificant. It's something they can hold up to show an adult, something they can point to and say, "This is where I need to be. Help me get here."

When I reflect on my own life, it occurs to me that I was born lost. We all were. It was only in Eden that a human being ever knew what it was to be at home. In Eden, I would imagine, the feeling of safety was so natural that it was only noticed after it was gone. But original sin came like a noisy crowd to bear us away from the place we needed to be, and since that time, our human lives have played out against a backdrop of insecurity and unfamiliarity. We are cold and alone and confused. And God, our heartbroken parent, never stops seeking us, never stops calling our names.

Baptism, the etching of God's law onto our heart and soul, is not a phone number written on our arms. It's something far better — it's a homing signal, planted deep within. And it will lead us back to where we need to be.






