## CELEBRATING FOURTY YEARS OF FAITH









#### Sunday Reflection

Fr. Ed Smith

#### Acts 2:1-11; 1 Corinthians 12:3b-7, 12-13; John 20:19-23

Recently, our eighth-grade students were confirmed in our parish church. During the conferral of the sacrament, they were anointed with chrism and were told: "Be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit." It was a powerful moment for all who were there. Not only was this the culmination of much preparation on the part of the young people involved, and not only was it the final Sacrament of Initiation they would receive, but it was also the beginning of a new relationship for them with God and the Church as they grow into mature witnesses of their faith through the power of the Holy Spirit.

As we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost, we recall the great gift sent by Jesus to His very new Church: the same gift of the Holy Spirit that our students received in their Confirmation. But it is good to remember that this gift did not "cure" everything in that early Church: There were still divisions; there were still confusions; there were still growing pains.

However, there was something new in life, or, more accurately, there was SOMEONE new: The person of the Holy Spirit, who is the love between the Father and the Son, who is given to us in a special way in Baptism and Confirmation, who is invoked over the bread and wine at Mass, and who leads and guides the Church in every age. This enables us to be confident in our faith: knowing that we are not alone, that the Church is guided well, and that we can grow in love as God's holy people even when it seems nearly impossible.

As those young men and women of our parish received the gift of the Spirit in a special sacrament, followed by the traditional greeting: "Peace be with you," let us be confident in the gift we have all been given as members of the Church, knowing that a life of peace, purpose and joy is not only possible, but right in front of us. Jesus said to His disciples: "Peace be with you," He also says it to us, over and over, not only at our Confirmation!

#### **Spirit to Spirit**

Talk to any couple who are devoted to one another. Ask them when they realized they were in love — call-me-in-a-crisis love, face-the-day-to-day-with-me love — and the answer will probably not be "When I realized he was only dating me to win a bet with his boss."

If you know what movie that references, you and 12-year-old me would have been great friends.

Like any other self-respecting American tween of the early 2000s, I used to watch a lot of romantic comedies. I forget how old I was when I realized that romantic comedies are actually ... really boring. Not because they're about love — true love is fascinating. I could watch real-life people talk about who they love for hours.

Because when we say we love someone – truly love them – what we mean is we love their spirit. We love what they are. We love the qualities that escape description, the attributes we have to talk around or reduce to cliche in order to define. We cannot love a body alone. We cannot love a name or a reputation. We cannot love a story that we've built around a relationship.

To be in love with someone you need to know their spirit. Intimately. And that knowledge cannot help but change everything about you. It changes your goals, your understanding of the world. It changes the amount of courage you have to face the life ahead of you. It changes your ability to be who God wants you to be.

The disciples lived and ate and walked with Jesus for three whole years before they really knew his spirit. They didn't know it on Good Friday when they scattered and hid and wept. They didn't know it on Easter Sunday, when they couldn't believe what they saw. They thought they loved him, but when push came to shove their love failed.

But by the end of their lives, the disciples knew the kind of love that sustained them even in the face of martyrdom.

What was it that changed? It was the Spirit. They finally knew the Spirit.

#### Everyday Stewardship

On this Pentecost Sunday, if you come to Mass at my parish you will see a sea of red all around. The choir, the lectors, the extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion, the people in the pews, and of course the celebrant and our deacon, will all be wearing red. We are one of those parishes that strive to reflect the color of the liturgy in our dress. It can be a sight to see.

What we put on our bodies serves only as a reminder of what is really important during these liturgical celebrations. At Pentecost, it was the Spirit of God that filled those in the first Christian community. We wear red to call to mind that very Spirit, often depicted as a fire or flame. However, if we just use red as a reminder of the power of the Spirit without letting it change us, then our actions become merely sentimental.

We are filled with the Holy Spirit through the sacraments of the Church. God touches us and enters into us in a profound way, just like in that upper room at Pentecost. That first powerful movement of the Spirit led to a Church that grew and flourished and remains alive today. What is the movement of the Spirit within calling you to do today? Do we allow God to move us and do great things through us? Red is a bold color to wear at any time. But our actions should be even bolder.


