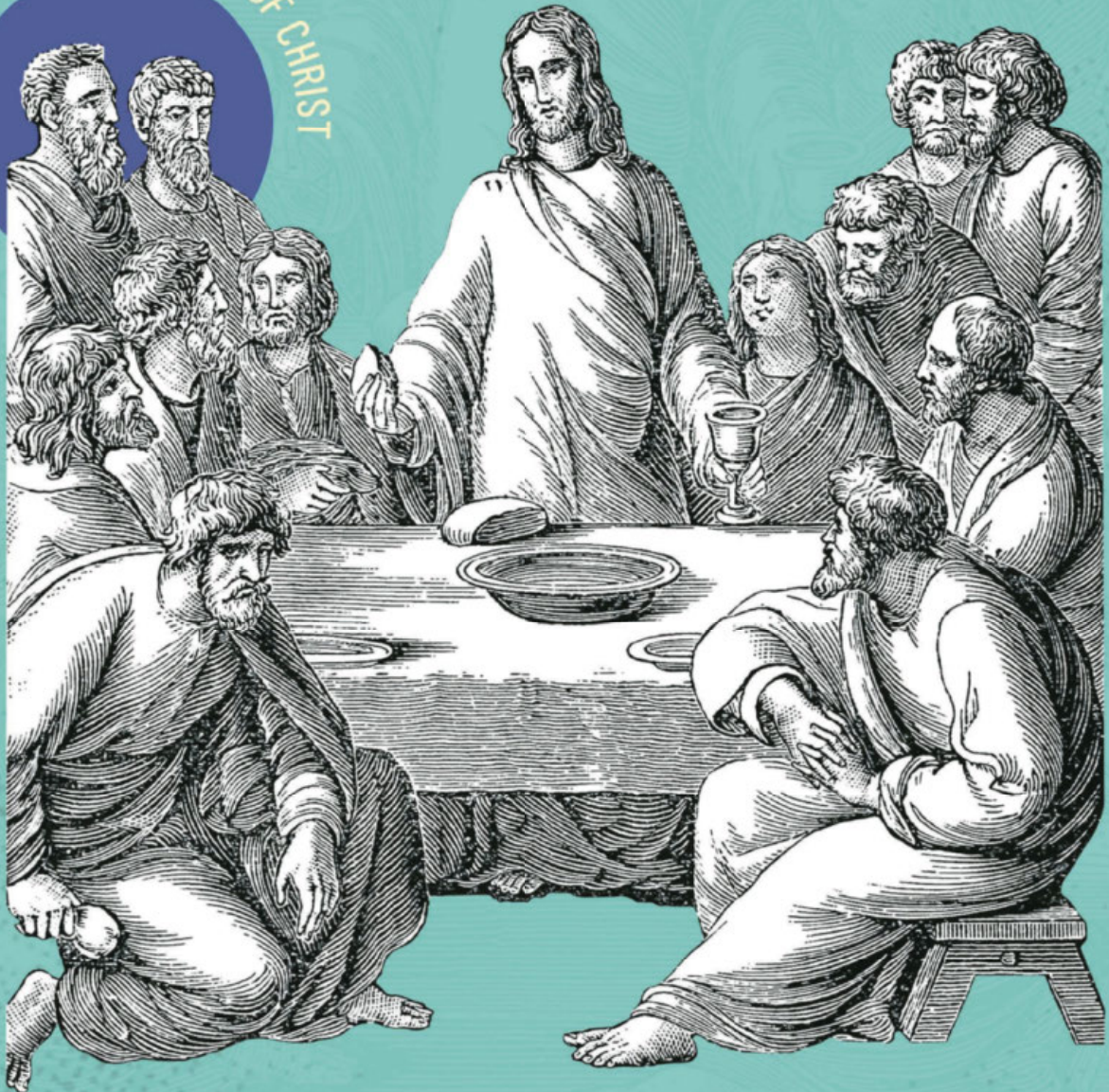

Sunday Reflection

Fr. Ed Smith

Exodus 24:3-8; Hebrews 9:11-15; Mark 14:12-16, 22-26

Our parish Worship Commission meets periodically to discuss the importance of the liturgies we celebrate here. We speak about music, priests, deacons, ushers and ministers, but always we remember that the Eucharist is central, and that everything else comes from this. This is what makes us unique as Catholics: the Eucharist is the center of our worship and the core of our faith community as we gather at Mass. The reason for this is that the Eucharist is not merely some kind of 'remembrance' of Jesus, but is, in fact, the true Body and Blood of Christ that we celebrate and receive at every liturgy.

It is true that Jesus is with us in many ways, but the Eucharist is a unique and special presence of Jesus. Moreover, it is His gift of himself to His people. Jesus does not institute the Sacrament of His Body and Blood in order to prove that He can accomplish a miracle, but in order to share Himself with his beloved people: us.

This weekend's beautiful reading from St. Mark's Gospel, recounting the Last Supper, shows Jesus with His disciples saying of the bread: "This is my Body;" and saying of the wine: "This is my blood." Jesus means what He says. He can be trusted. We can believe Him. He gives Himself. The Eucharist, then, is a celebration of Christ and His people, His sacrifice for us in love, His body broken, His blood poured out for us. And we are given the opportunity not only to share in this glorious reality, but also be changed by it.

On this feast of The Body and Blood of Christ [Corpus Christi], we thank God for the gift of His Son, and we thank His Son for the gift of the Eucharist. Let us also thank one another for gathering as a community of faith as we share in this holy meal, which is a Sacrament of Divine Love.

This Is My Body

A friend in high school once asked me why I wore a Crucifix around my neck. She was a Christian and very devout, so I was surprised at her confusion. "To remember Jesus' sacrifice," I said.

Her upper lip curled in disgust. "The cross is a sign of Jesus' sacrifice," she said. "He's not on the cross anymore. It's really weird that you wear his dead body."

As someone raised Catholic, the Corpus was an image I knew intimately. We had Crucifixes all over our home, everyone in my family did. And for reasons I couldn't quite explain, I actually preferred them over the plain crosses I saw elsewhere. The crosses seemed more elegant, more refined — but the Crucifixes felt more complete. More to-the-point.

My friend's disgust compelled me to reflect, in a way I never had before, on the image of Christ's body, wounded and twisted and tortured. Why was this a visual that compelled me? It didn't make a lot of sense for someone who abhorred dead bodies so much that I found it difficult to look into a casket at a wake. So, what was different about this?

My friend wasn't wrong: Christ is no longer on the cross. The sacrifice has been made. But does that mean it is over? We re-present it every single Mass. It's the point of everything that we do. Jesus did not sacrifice his spirit; he sacrificed his body. He bought us with every tear of the flesh, with every drop of blood.

The cross is crucial, yes. But that wood didn't bleed for us. If the body wasn't the point, Jesus would not have become human at all. Jesus needed the body.

We need it, too.

We Can Prepare the Upper Room

We all know that person, don't we? Hey, maybe we've even been that person.

"I have a great relationship with God, but I don't go to church regularly. God and I are on good terms. I can talk to Him just fine on my own."

There isn't anything false in these statements. It's important to have an intimate, even conversational prayer relationship with God. But the problem with this attitude is that it implies that churches don't matter. Community worship doesn't matter. Today, we are reminded exactly why that is so untrue. Why we need our parishes, our priests, and each other.

The Body and Blood of Christ — that's what it's all about. If it's not about that, it's not about anything. If we don't have the Eucharist, we're just like the ancient priests, making sacrifices that don't have the power to redeem anybody.

Where do we receive the Body and Blood of Christ? For most of us, it's in our parishes. The altar of sacrifice is also the table we gather in front of, as a family, to become one with Christ in the truest and realest way possible, recreating the scene in the Upper Room over and over again every time Mass is celebrated.

The disciples were commissioned by Christ to prepare the Upper Room for the Last Supper. How can we take up that work ourselves? How can we strengthen the bonds in our spiritual family? How can we serve our parish, always remembering that the table is not meant to be set only for two?
