## Sunday Reflection

Fr. Ed Smith

Ezekiel 17:22-24; 2 Corinthians 5:6-10; Mark 4:26-34

Happy Father's Day to all the dads in our parish! For many of us, when we were very young, we saw our fathers as something bigger than life, and we forgot that they were people who were still growing. In this weekend's Gospel from St. Mark, Jesus speaks of "people", of the importance of "seeds" and the remarkable growth that can come from them. Like seeds, we must be given time to grow up into healthy human beings: mentally, spiritually and physically. In order for this to occur, a relationship with God has to take root in us, be given time to develop, be nourished and cared for, and be allowed to mature so that it transforms us.

Jesus once again shows how much he really understands people. He knows that a dramatic, 'instant' conversion to God can be exciting in a person's life, but that this is not enough. It is the daily growth in faith, hope and love that is the lifeblood of a true disciple and that is evidence of an authentic conversion of heart. It is the patient, gradual development of ourselves in Christ, growing as selfless, compassionate, and joyful human beings that provides the rich ground for God's Word to take root and flower in us.

When this begins to happen, we might notice that God is already deeply involved in our lives as "people", not just as detached souls. We can become what Our Lord wants us to be and be grateful that we are beloved creations of a Heavenly Father. And this is a wonderful thing to think about on this Father's Day!

## Campus Safety: Essential Reminders During Construction

Now that summer is here and SMOY is in full construction site mode, here are a few safety reminders for us all:

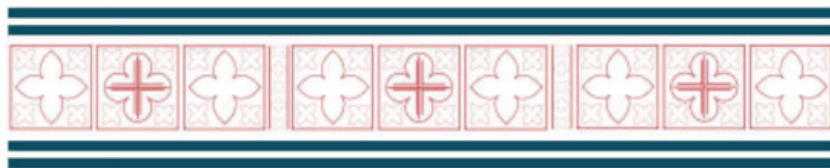
1. The school building is a construction site and as such, no one but construction workers can access the building until further notice. The school office will be hard at work, but there will not be regular business hours. Please contact the school if you need to make an appointment.

2. The only legal way to make a left turn onto the SMOY campus from Columbia Rd is at the traffic light. Please do not attempt a left turn from Columbia Rd into the Right In/Right Out driveway. We have had quite a few near accidents between those illegally entering what is an exit only lane and those attempting to exit at the same time.

3. There will be construction vehicles entering and exiting the property. Please be mindful and cautious.

4. Because of the construction, the playground and basketball hoops will be closed and off limits until further notice. This is to protect our children and to keep them away from what will be an active construction site with many moving parts all day long.

Thank you for not attempting to enter the construction site at any time. We will be posting pictures and short videos of the progress on a regular basis as this exciting new entrance and office space takes shape. We also want to thank you in advance for helping us keep the SMOY campus safe during this phase of our growth. # Practicing Catholic

## In the Family Way

Look here: there is no one more family-oriented than me. I drive a minivan. I wear mom jeans. I wipe unidentified gunk off of kids' faces without a second thought.

I'm all about family, but I'm not always a fan of what "family" has come to mean in the modern lexicon. Family values. Family-friendly. Family-oriented. It's usually a synonym for "non-offensive." Soft. Moderate. Nice.

It's all fine, I suppose. But is it genuine? Creating a family, bringing that family physically into the world, was the hardest and most painful thing I ever did. The care and keeping of that family – the teamwork with my spouse, the feeding and watering of the children, the teaching of the writing and the reading and the praying – it's very hardcore. It's not all stuffed animals and peekaboo. It's a mental, spiritual, and physical challenge that daily brings me to my knees.

I'm not even talking exclusively about parenting young children. I'm talking about being part of a family in any way – being a son, being a daughter, being a sister and cousin and uncle. Families are complicated and strange and messy. Sometimes boundaries need to be drawn, or they need to be crossed. Sometimes walls need to be put up or torn down. It's never easy. It's never simple.

But I've never known someone who didn't want to be part of a family in some way, whether that's a blood family or one created by circumstance. And there's a reason Christ creates a family ("Whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother") and not a club.

A family is a crucible, yes – but what comes out is so much more beautiful than what went in. For all the effort and even pain that is sometimes involved in a family relationship, there is nothing more defining, more fulfilling.

We are part of Christ's family, and what we can expect from that is certainly not a life of simple, clear-cut, undemanding discipleship. We can expect confusion. We can expect discomfort. But we can expect to be perpetually drawn to the heart of one who loves us without hesitation, without condition.

In the end, we're family.

# Everyday Stewardship

I have coached all three of my children in soccer at some time in their lives. I loved teaching them and their teammates the importance of functioning as one unit. If we were not all moving together toward victory, we would all find ourselves together in defeat. We used to go through one drill I called the "human foosball." We would scrimmage with players in lines like on a foosball table. If you ever got too far behind or too far ahead of those in your line, play would stop and the ball would go to the other team. The goal was to help build an awareness of where your teammates were on the pitch and to teach the lesson that no one player is a team onto themselves.

As disciples and stewards, we sometimes find ourselves far behind or maybe even too far ahead. As a consequence, our actions either hinder the ability of the Body of Christ to evangelize and pass on the faith to a new generation or present the Church as an entity that sees itself as judgmental or too holy to be in the world. We are called to community, and in that community, we must be aware of our brothers and sisters in the faith. At times, we need to help them grow in their faith. Other times, we need to slow down and realize that we cannot change the world on our own. We all have unique gifts we are called to share, and we can only bear true witness to the power of the Body of Christ when we are all moving together and making each other strong.
