
Columbia Road at Davis Rd Construction Begins Soon

Columbia Road and Davis Road/Myrtle Ave. intersection will be closed for the construction of a roundabout beginning Monday, July 22, 2024, for sixteen (16) weeks, weather permitting. Columbia Road closure location is between addresses 9311 and 9228. All addresses along Davis Road will only have access from the east. During Phase I of the road closure, Myrtle Ave. will have access from the north until traffic is switched, then during Phase II – access will be from the south.

The detour for Columbia Road closure will utilize Fields-Ertel Road and US22/SR3. The detour for Davis Road closure will



utilize Rich Road, Fields-Ertel Road, and US22/SR3. Myrtle Ave. will have access from Columbia Road.

Sunday Reflection

Fr. Ed Smith

Proverbs 9:1-6; Ephesians 5:15-20; John 6:51-58

"I want to be with you."


Fr. Gene Maly, one of the great scripture scholars of the last century, and a priest of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, said that this was one of the most important things that God says to His people. It is a statement of intimacy and trust. It reveals that we are created out of love and that God wishes to share Himself with us. This is what love is all about. This is what the Eucharist is all about: Love.

Jesus, in the clearest of terms, tells us that His flesh is true food, and His blood is true drink. Consider what has just been said. Without belief, it sounds almost unbelievable and even perhaps bizarre; but approached in the vision of our faith, it is a profound testament to our loving relationship with Jesus, the gift that He is in our lives, the reality of His sacramental presence in the Eucharist, and the promise made in today's Gospel that we will remain in Him, and we will have life because of Him.

This is why the Church has been meditating on the sixth chapter of St. John's Gospel for the past several Sundays. This chapter, often called the 'Discourse on the Bread of Life', reminds us that Jesus did not simply live a long time ago and then disappeared, but that He continues to live as the Risen Christ, present in our world, our Church, and our hearts.

Jesus, who is the Bread of life, tells us over and over again: "I want to be with you." Let us all pray that we will learn to say the same thing to Him!
