





Sunday Reflection

Fr. Ed Smith

Wisdom 2:12, 17-20; James 3:16-4:3; Mark 9:30-37

"Look out for number one" is a sad but pervasive mantra for too many people in the world. But what do these people want? Some want to be in charge; others want to make sure they are first in line; a few are convinced that they know more than everyone else and therefore should make all the rules. It can almost take your breath away. Well, sometimes the Gospel confronts all of this. And in today's reading from the Gospel of St. Mark Jesus clearly confronts the petty ambitions of some of the apostles, and after this. He teaches them a great lesson by presenting a little child to them. Not only that, He tells them that if they receive such a child, they are also receiving Jesus and His Father. And even though these pronouncements might seem unrelated at first, it is the virtue of "humility" that holds them together. The apostles realize their lack of humility once Jesus, asks what they were arguing about [who was the greatest among them?]. And then, Jesus not only brings a little child before them, but also puts His arms around the child, and gives him as an example of humility, love and trust. So, our special word for this weekend is "humility". Jesus asks us all to embrace it, live it out, and give a good example of its beauty to others. He did it for us, and therefore we should do the same for our brothers and sisters. So, our life is not meant to "look out for number one," which is self-centered and destructive. Rather, life is an opportunity to love and serve others, to be grateful for who and what we are, to accept our own limitations, and to realize that we are not in control of everything and certainly not meant to be! Remember the refrain to our Responsorial Psalm which reminds us that it is the Lord who upholds our life! Let's look for Him rather than looking out for ourselves. This is the way to really be the people God meant us to be!
