



Sunday Reflection

Fr. Ed Smith

Isaiah 53:10-11: Hebrews 4:14-16: Mark 10:35-45

After an evening meeting in our parish, I periodically see some of our young people in the gym, practicing for an upcoming game of volleyball or basketball. They work very hard and are diligent in building on their strengths and addressing their weaknesses as they prepare to face another team. I have noticed how strongly they focus, and the phrase "no pain, no gain" has come to my mind more than once.

It seems to me that this saying is worth repeating as we read the Gospel for this Sunday, since the sons of Zebedee want the "gain" [to sit next to Jesus in His glory in heaven] without any "pain." Earlier in chapter 10 of Mark's Gospel, Jesus made it clear that He would suffer, die, and be raised up. The disciples were not happy to hear this, and seemed to misunderstand that, without the suffering and death, the glory of the resurrection would make no sense. They still needed to learn that suffering would be part of their lives, and that suffering can be redemptive, purifying, and holy.

It is also good for us to remember this. In one way or another, we are all going to experience suffering some time in life. No one enjoys this. But, if we approach it from the vantage point of our faith, looking at the example of Jesus, we see that suffering can lead to a deeper relationship with God, a more complete trust in His care, and a growth in compassion for others.

So, yes, we certainly do want what the sons of Zebedee desire: to sit next to Jesus in the Kingdom of heaven. But we cannot forget that a crucial part of the journey to get there is embracing the cross. And this is the "pain" that also brings the "gain" of eternal life!
