Sunday Reflection

Fr. Ed Smith

1 Kings 17:10-16; Hebrews 9:24-28; Mark 12:38-44


On Monday of next week our country celebrates Veterans Day, on which we remember the sacrifices of so many men and women who have been in military service for our nation. We thank God for their service and are inspired by their sacrifice. The reality of "Sacrifice" is something that people can approach with much trepidation.

But we have been given a marvelous lesson in sacrifice in the first reading and the Gospel this weekend! The widow in the First Book of Kings sacrifices all the food she has left in the house for the prophet Elijah, and then, to her astonishment, finds that there is enough left to eat for her and her son for a full year. The widow in the Gospel contributes two small coins, all the money she has, to the temple and is held up by Jesus as an example of true generosity, holiness and humility.

The reason that both widows could make such sacrifices was because of love: love for God and His people. Yes, they sacrificed much, but received so much in return. So. the word for today is "sacrifice". It comes from two Latin words and literally means: "to make holy". This definition reveals how important sacrifice is in Christian life, and how beautiful. Too often it is seen simply as something to be endured, something negative, something painful. But it is so much more than that.

There is a marvelous line in the old Catholic Exhortation for Marriage that was proclaimed to brides and grooms before they pronounced their vows at their wedding: "Sacrifice is difficult...only love can make it easier...and perfect love can make it a joy." This sense of "joy" in sacrifice might sound alien to many people these days. But imagine life without it. How much would people suffer with no one to comfort them, or take time for them, or respond to a crisis, or not meet their crucial needs? This is sacrifice. And as always happens when something is done in faith, the one who makes the sacrifice receives much more than is given up. St. Francis of Assisi states it clearly in his wonderful prayer: "It is in giving that we receive." And he is absolutely correct!


INVITE ONE CATHOLIC BACK TO MASS




