Sunday Reflection

Fr. Ed Smith

Daniel 7:13-14: Revelation 1:5-8: John 18:33b-37

Happy Feast Day! This weekend the Church all over the world celebrates the solemnity of Christ the King, and since we call ourselves "Christians" and are children of the Kingdom, this is not just another feast day but "OUR" feast day! And this year we celebrate 40 years of life as a parish family, thanking God for the immense gifts that He has given to this community of faith in this little corner of His Kingdom.

There is so much to celebrate, and, at first glance, it seems strange that the Gospel for this Sunday comes from the long reading from Passion of St. John's Gospel that we hear on Good Friday: Jesus being interrogated by Pontius Pilate. Ironically, it is Pilate who asks the question of Jesus that we should all be asking: "Are you a king?"

For us, who are believers who want to be His followers, we may ask this question in a slightly different way: "Are You MY King?" This means a great deal. Do we really see Jesus as our Lord and King? Do we acknowledge Him as our way, truth and life? Do we want to serve Him with our whole being?

As we conclude the Church's liturgical year and prepare for Advent, these are very good questions for our reflection. Jesus, in today's Gospel, tells us clearly what we must do to be His follower. He says: "Listen to my voice." There are many voices that surround us in the world telling us: what to do, whom we should follow, how we should act, and what we should believe in. With all this, it is important to remember that the voice of Jesus will ultimately give us true direction, wisdom, and inspiration.

Today is important because it reminds us that Jesus is our King, that we are His people, and that our lives are beautifully united in the call to love God and one another. May God bless all of us as we celebrate this holy feast, listening attentively to the gentle voice of Christ our King.
