Sunday Reflection

Fr. Ed Smith

The Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

1 Samuel 26:2, 7-9, 12-13, 22-23; 1 Corinthians 15:45-49; Luke 6:27-38

Periodically, people have asked me where I get the ideas for these little reflections, and I can tell you that much of what ends up here results from being part of this wonderful parish. Living in this vibrant community of faith helps me to communicate whatever small insights I might have about our weekly readings.

So, let's look at our Gospel for this Sunday. Jesus tells his disciples to "love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you." These heroic acts of faith might seem nearly impossible, but when we remember that Jesus not only gives us an example of how to do this through His own life, but also the gift of His grace which helps us to do this ourselves, His expectation for us takes on new possibilities.

With Jesus as our guide, brother, and Lord, we can accomplish things we would never have dreamt of previously. We are called to go beyond the merely acceptable life of any decent human being, to a life of forgiveness, generosity and love, that brings the image of God to our world more clearly. This is certainly not always easy, but it is what makes us Christians. So, as we continue to reflect on God's Word together each week, it always comes down to listening to Jesus, following his example, asking for His help, and trying to live out His love. Not a bad way to live as a human being!



Welcome Archbishop-Designate Casey



Pope Francis has accepted the resignation of Most Reverend Dennis M. Schnurr from pastoral governance of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati and has appointed Most Reverend Robert G. Casey, Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Chicago, as the 11th archbishop of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati.

Archbishop-designate Casey has been a priest for more than 30 years, having been ordained to the priesthood for the Archdiocese of Chicago in 1994. He was ordained a Bishop in 2018 by Most Reverend Blase J. Cupich, Cardinal Archbishop of Chicago.

Ouestion

If I go to the **Sacrament of Penance** and end up repeating the same sins, does that mean I do not have a strong enough intention to amend my life?

Answer

There is a popular expression that says, "Be patient. God isn't finished with me yet!" Growing in faith and holiness is an ongoing, life-long project, and our struggle with sin is at the heart of it. As St. Paul says, the good he intends to do, he does not do. The evil he does not intend, he does! It is not always a lack of intention, but more often the allure of evil that makes it difficult to change.

When we confess our sins, we are to come with a fully contrite heart. You need to reflect on your true feelings toward your actions before approaching the sacrament. After confession, there are strategies you can make to avoid falling into the same traps of sin. First, pray for and seek out strength and perseverance through multiple sacraments, charitable work, and personal sacrifice. Second, avoid occasions of sin when you might fail or be sorely tempted. In doing these things, remind yourself daily that it is a spiritual war we wage, and with God's grace, we will succeed.


Anointing of the Catechumens: A Sacred Rite

Ash Wednesday, March 5 and Good Friday, April 18 are days of abstinence from meat and also days of fast, that is, limited to a single full meal. The other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat. The law of abstinence binds all Catholics 14 years and older. The law of fasting binds all Catholics from their 18th birthday until their 59th birthday (canons 97, 1252). "Let the paschal fast be kept sacred. Let it be celebrated everywhere on Good Friday and, where possible, prolonged throughout Holy Saturday, so that the joys of the Sunday of the Resurrection may be attained with uplifted and clear mind." (Constitution on the Liturgy, No. 110)




