Sunday Reflection

Fr. Ed Smith

The Third Sunday of Lent

Exodus 3:1-8a, 13-15; 1 Corinthians 10: 1-6, 10-12; Matthew 13:1-9

Moses standing before the burning bush is one of the most vivid images in the Book of Exodus. It teaches us that God is here, with us, revealing His presence and His plan. It also calls us to faith: beginning with an awareness of God's nearness to us, His calling of each of us by name [as He does with Moses] and sending us out to proclaim His message.

Sometimes, it is the issue of awareness that can be the most difficult. It can be easy to ignore the reality of God in the world. But our readings remind us that God is here with us, making a difference, and transforming us in His love. He asks us to pay attention to His presence, listen carefully to His words, and respond with a generous heart. Recall that Moses is attentive, realizes that he is on holy ground, and even takes off his shoes to show he understands what is happening. He listens to God's voice, and goes forth to proclaim God's message of comfort, liberty and faith.

What does this have to do with us? Everything. God is here, and if we are not careful, we can miss His burning presence in our world and concern ourselves with the judgment of others, as well as secondary issues that distract us from Him. This reminds me of a poem by Elizabeth Barrett Browning [I am an old English major], in which she wrote:

*Earth's crammed with heaven,
and every common bush afire with God,
but only he who sees takes off his shoes,
the rest sit 'round it and pluck blackberries.*

Let us ask God to help us see Him, so that we do not waste our time with unnecessary judgments, wasteful activity, and selfish thoughts, rather than being attentive to His presence, His word, His love for us, and His message of peace.

The Journey to Becoming Catholic

On March 9th, the RCIA catechumens and candidates celebrated two Rites to begin their final preparation for initiation into the Catholic Church. At SMOY, Father Stephen presided over the Rite of Sending, where the candidates and catechumen's godparents, sponsors, and catechists attested to their preparation and conversion of heart and then recommended that they be sent to the Archbishop for the Rite of Election and Call to Continuing Conversion.

That same afternoon, all our catechumens and candidates were presented to Father Steve Angi as Vicar General for the Archbishop at St. Peter in Chains Basilica. These rights began the Period of Purification and Enlightenment that begins a period of more intense reflection, prayer, and study of the Sacraments of the Church. We can't wait for the Easter Vigil where they will be baptized, confirmed, and receive their first Holy Communion. Please keep them in your prayers.





March 28, 2025 Jubilee 24 Hours for the Lord

Pope Francis opened the 2025 Jubilee Year under the theme "Pilgrims of Hope," emphasizing a renewed trust in God, the Church, and society.

As part of the celebration, Pope Francis has designated special jubilees throughout the year, each honoring different vocations, life stages, or themes. Upcoming Jubilees include those for Missionaries of Mercy (March 28-30) and Sick and Health Care Workers (April 5-6). These events offer moments of prayer, reflection, and celebration, recognizing holiness in various aspects of life and encouraging the faithful to support one another in their spiritual journeys.

24 Hours for the Lord

A holy hour is the practice of spending one hour's time in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament, praying and meditating on the agony of Jesus Christ. More broadly, a holy hour can also refer to any 60 minutes set aside in prayer and reflection, whether in church or elsewhere.

The holy hour devotion dates to the late 17th century, when St. Margaret Mary Alacoque received visions of Jesus Christ. In these visions, the Lord requested that St. Margaret Mary spend one hour every Thursday evening lying prostrate and meditating upon his agony in the Garden of Gethsemane. This practice calls back to the Gospel of Matthew, which tells of Jesus' desire for the disciples to "remain here and keep watch with me" (Matthew 26:38) as he awaited his passion.

Caregiver Assistance Network - Become a Volunteer!

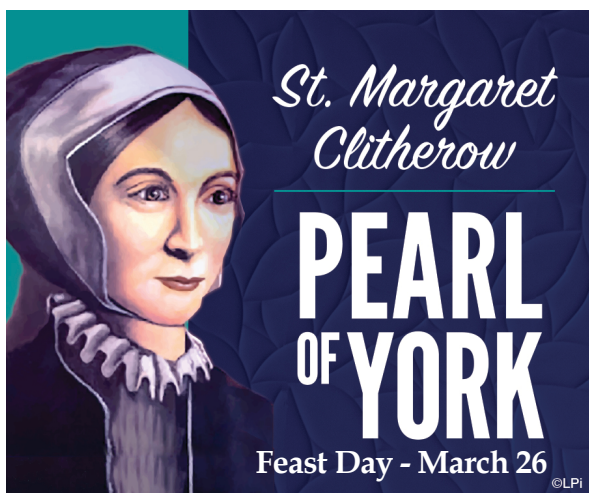
