#### Jubilee Pilgrimages

During the Jubilee year, Catholics worldwide will be "pilgrims of hope," traveling—physically and spiritually—to sacred sites, drawing closer to God's mercy, and renewing their commitment to living as followers of Christ.

#### What is a Pilgrimage? Why do people go on them?

A pilgrimage is a spiritual journey to visit a holy site, such as the shrine of a saint, a place where the Blessed Virgin Mary has appeared, or an historic church or chapel.

What makes a pilgrimage different from a vacation and a pilgrim distinct from a tourist is the spirit in which the journey is made. Pilgrimages are really a symbol of our spiritual journey in life, reminding us that this world is not our true home and that we spend our lives journeying to our homeland, which is the Kingdom of God.

Pilgrimages—which can be as involved as a trip to Rome or the Holy Land or as simple as visiting the Blessed Sacrament in a local parish church—are also an opportunity for us to step out of the rhythms and limits of our daily lives to seek out connection with God in a special way, by visiting a holy place.

At times, such as on a special feast, a jubilee, or the anniversary of the dedication of the church, special graces (called "indulgences") can also be offered to pilgrims, helping to enrich our experience of the celebration. ©LPi

- The Cathedral Basilica of Saint Peter in Chains in Cincinnati
- The Shrine of the Holy Relics at Maria Stein
- Emmanuel Catholic Church in Dayton

## Sunday Reflection



The Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time Sirach 27:4-7: 1 Corinthians 15:54-58: Luke 6:39-45

"You can't give what you don't have!" This old proverb comes to mind as we read our Gospel for this weekend. Jesus uses dramatic imagery to make his point: the blind leading the blind; trying to remove a splinter in someone's eye when you have a wooden beam in your own eye.

In these short, parable-like pronouncements of Jesus, He makes it clear that WE have to be converted first, before we ever try and make changes in anyone else. More than that, if we are not really converted [literally: change of heart], then what we attempt to hand over to others might not be only incorrect, but also destructive. We are capable of doing much better. With Jesus on our side [and He always is] we can communicate God's love, gentleness and faithfulness as He wants us to do.

So, how do we do this? St. Paul, in our passage from 1 Corinthians, makes it very clear: "My beloved brothers and sisters, be firm, steadfast, always devoted to the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain." Our relationship with Jesus makes it possible to help bring others to God, be light for the world, and share the great virtues that make life worth living: Faith, Hope and Love.



#### **Event: Taizé Candlelight Experience**







# ADORATION



"...when I go to Adoration, personally, I think of walking into a restaurant and asking for a quiet place for a table for two... just me and Jesus. It's just an intimate one-on-one of liking each other, I pray a bit; I read a bit. I just enjoy His company. - Mary, SMOY parishioner

Adoration is simply prayer in front of the Blessed Sacrament, which anyone can do at any time when they are in front of a Tabernacle.

During official Adoration a consecrated host will be exposed in a **Monstrance**, a sacred vessel used to display the Blessed Sacrament. This is called **Exposition**. You can pray in Adoration for as long or short as you wish. People who commit to pray with Jesus for a specific hour are called Eucharistic Guardians.




